Welcome to the EdFunder website (the "Platform") made available by EdFunder, LLC. (including its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, and service providers, collectively, "EdFunder," "we," "us," and/or "our") . This Platform is operated by EdFunder and has been created to permit users to post a fundraising campaign to accept monetary contributions to our users and visitors ("you," and/or "your"). Except as provided below, this Privacy Policy describes and governs how we collect, use, share and protect data collected from users of or visitors to the Platform.

Before you use or submit any information through or in connection with the Platform, please carefully review this Privacy Policy. By using any part of the Platform, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of your information as further outlined in this Privacy Policy.

**Information We Collect**

As further described below, when you use or otherwise access the Platform, we may collect information in multiple ways, including when you provide information directly to us, and when we passively collect information from your browser or device.

**Information That You Provide Directly to Us:**

We collect information from you (including, but not limited to, your name, email address, and location) when you voluntarily provide such information, such as when you contact us with inquiries, respond to one of our surveys, provide us with feedback, register for access to the Platform.

You may also provide us with information relating to third parties—including information stored in your email and mobile device address books—such as, without limitation, names, email addresses, and phone numbers of your contacts (collectively, "Third-Party Data"). The Platform may request your permission to access such Third-Party Data.

We collect this information for the purposes described below. While you are under no obligation to directly provide us with such information, should you choose to withhold such information, we may not be able to provide you with some or all of the Platform. We acknowledge and agree that any personal data you provide may be transferred from your current location to the offices and servers of EdFunder and the authorized third parties referred to herein located in the United States.

Our Platform may include online comments. Please remember that any information that is disclosed in these areas becomes public information for both us and other users to use and share. Please be considerate and respectful of others while using the

community to share your opinions. We reserve the right, but do not have the obligation, to review and monitor such posting or any other content on our Platform, and to remove postings or content that may be viewed as inappropriate or offensive to others.

### **Information That is Passively or Automatically Collected**

**Device & Usage Information:** When you interact with EdFunder through the Platform, we automatically receive and store certain information from devices that you use to access the Platform. This information is collected passively using various technologies, and includes the type of internet browser or mobile device you use, any website from which you have come to the Platform, your operating system, and may include location data through an IP address that identifies the city and state where you logged into the Platform or your precise geo-location if you have permitted your mobile device to provide that information to us. EdFunder may store such information itself or such information may be included in databases owned and maintained by EdFunder affiliates, agents or service providers. **Aggregated Data:** In an ongoing effort to better understand and serve the users of the Platform, EdFunder often conducts research on its customer demographics, interests and behavior based on information we collect. We may de-identify and/or aggregate the information collected through the Platform for research purposes or any other purposes, and we may share this data with our affiliates, agents, business partners, or other third parties.

### **Location Information:**

When you use the Platform to organize a fundraising campaign, the Platform may request that you provide your school, city or town and state or province of residence. Please keep in mind that other users of the Platform may be able to view your, school, city or town and state or province of residence in connection with the campaign, if it is made available within EdFunder's School Search Directory. We may also use your location information in an aggregate way, as described above in the "Aggregated Data" section.

**Cookies and Other Electronic Technologies:**When you interact with the Platform, we try to make that experience simple and meaningful. When you visit our Platform, our web server sends a cookie to your computer or mobile device. Cookies are small pieces of information that are issued to your computer or mobile device when you visit a website or access or use a mobile application, and that store and sometimes track information about your use of the Platform. A number of cookies we use last only for the duration of your web or application session and expire when you close your browser or exit the application. Other cookies are used to remember you when you return to the Platform and will last longer.

Some of the cookies used by the Platform are set by us, and some are set by third parties who are delivering Platform on our behalf. We may use cookies, and similar

technologies to cookies, to collect information about your access and use of the Platform. For example, we may use cookies or other technologies that: (1) allow you to navigate and use all the features provided by our Platform; (2) customize elements of the layout and/or content within the Platform and remember that you have visited us before; (3) identify the number of unique visitors we receive; (4) allow us to provide you with a customized experience; and (5) inform us how you use the Platform (including how long you spend on the Platform) and where you have come to the Platform from, so that we can improve the Platform and learn which functions of the Platform are most popular with users. As we adopt additional technologies, we may also gather additional information through other methods.

Most web and mobile device browsers automatically accept cookies but, if you prefer, you can change your browser to prevent that or to notify you each time a cookie is set. You can also learn more about cookies by visiting [www.allaboutcookies.org](http://www.allaboutcookies.org), which includes additional useful information on cookies and how to block cookies using different types of browsers or mobile devices.

You may also consult the "Help" section of your browser for more information (e.g., [Internet Explorer](#); [Google Chrome](#); [Mozilla Firefox](#); or [Apple Safari](#)). You can also manage the use of Flash technologies, including cookies and local storage objects with the Flash management tools available at [Adobe's website](#). Please note that by blocking any or all cookies, you may not have access to certain features or offerings of the Platform.

If you are accessing our Platform through a mobile device, you can also update your privacy settings on your device by setting the "Limit Ad Tracking" and Diagnostics and Usage setting property located in the settings screen of your Apple iPhone or iPad, or by resetting your Android ID through apps that are available in the Play Store. You can also limit information collection by uninstalling the App on your device and you can use the standard uninstall process available as part of your device for this purpose.

Information From Social Networking Services: One of the special features of the Platform is that it may allow you to enable or log into the Platform via various Social Networking Service like Facebook or Instagram ("Social Networking Service(s)"). By directly integrating these Platform, we aim to make your online experiences richer and more personalized. To take advantage of this feature, we will ask you to provide your credentials for the applicable Social Networking Service in order to log-in to our Platform. When you add a Social Networking Service account to the Platform or log into the Platform using your Social Networking Service account, we will collect relevant information necessary to enable the Platform to access that Social Networking Service and your data contained within that Social Networking Service. As part of such integration, the Social Networking Service will provide us with access to certain

information (including, for example, your name and photograph, as well as other information that you permit the Social Network Service to share with us) that you have provided to the Social Networking Service, and we will use, store, and disclose such information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. However, please remember that the manner in which Social Networking Service use, store, and disclose your information is governed by the policies of such third parties, and EdFunder shall have no liability or responsibility for the privacy practices or other actions of any Social Networking Service that may be enabled within the Platform.

You may also have the option of posting your Platform activities to Social Networking Service when you access content through the Platform (for example, you may post to Facebook that you performed an activity on the Platform); you acknowledge that if you choose to use this feature, your friends, followers, and subscribers on any Social Networking Service you have enabled will be able to view such activity. Please visit the privacy policy of the relevant Social Networking Service to find out more information about your rights and choices.

### **Our Use of Information Collected**

EdFunder uses the information collected from the Platform in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. If you provide information for a certain reason, we may use the information in connection with the reason for which it was provided. For instance, if you contact us by email, we will use the information you provide to answer your question or resolve your problem. Also, if you provide information about yourself, or have provided (or otherwise permitted the Platform to access) any Third-Party Data, we will use your information and any such Third-Party Data to provide you with access to such Platform and to monitor your use of such Platform.

EdFunder may also use the information we collect through the Platform to help us in providing the Platform and support Platform, processing transactions, fulfilling requests for information, receiving and sending communications, updating marketing lists, analyzing data and research aimed at improving the accuracy, effectiveness, usability or popularity of the Platform, to personalize the content and advertising that you see on Platform and to understand how users interact with and use our advertisement and Platform, to associate your activities, customize content or tailor advertising across different device and browsers that you use to access the Platform (for instance, computers, tablets, mobile devices, applications and websites), to comply with state, local, federal or international laws, to enforce our Terms and Conditions and this Privacy Policy, as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy, or in assisting with other tasks from time to time. Please note that we may combine information that we collect from you and about you (including automatically-collected information) with information we obtain about you from our affiliates and/or non-affiliated third parties, and use such combined information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. We may also use the information collected from the "Information We Collect" section, such as device

identifiers and MAC addresses, to associate users' activities, customize content, or tailor advertising to those users across different devices and browsers (for instance, tablets, mobile devices and applications, and websites).

EdFunder may use the information collected through the Platform to contact you about Platform we believe will be of interest to you. If we do so, each marketing communication we send you will contain instructions permitting you to "opt-out" of receiving future marketing communications or you can also send such opt-out request to [support@edfunder.com](mailto:support@edfunder.com). In addition, if at any time you wish not to receive any future marketing communications or you wish to have your name deleted from our mailing lists, please contact us as indicated below. If you opt out of receiving marketing communications or other information we think may interest you, as discussed below, we may still send you emails about your account or any Platform you have requested or received from us.

We may also use data collected through the Platform to send communications relating to the Platform, in accordance with applicable laws. For example, we may send periodic emails to registered users of the Platform relating to their recent interactions with the Platform, such as contributing to a campaign or "supporting" a campaign. Also, if you use any feature of the Platform permitting you to communicate with third parties (such as to refer a third party to the Platform or to communicate with them regarding a campaign or a contribution), either by submitting Third-Party Data to the Platform or otherwise permitting the Platform to automatically access Third-Party Data in your possession, you acknowledge and agree that you have the authority of the relevant third party for us to access and use the relevant Third-Party Data and that you have notified these third parties and informed them how their information is collected and used by EdFunder to provide the Platform. We reserve the right to identify you as the person who has made the referral in any messages that are sent to them. We may use Third-Party Data to (1) contact such third party using the Third-Party Data provided, and/or (2) provide you with an editable template message designed to facilitate communication between you and such third party through the Platform. In addition to sending the foregoing communications, we may also send reminders or related messages to you and to third parties on your behalf from time to time where permitted by applicable law. In each case, any such communications sent to third parties using Third-Party Data will provide a means to "opt-out" of receiving further communication of the same nature.

Our Disclosure of Information Collected Through the Platform There are certain circumstances in which we may share information collected through the Platform with certain third parties without further notice to you, as set forth below:

**Business Transfers:**

- As we develop our business, we might sell or buy businesses or assets. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, dissolution, similar event, or steps taken in anticipation of such events (e.g., due diligence in a transaction), user information may be part of the transferred assets.
- Agents, Consultants, Vendors and Related Third Parties:
- EdFunder, like many businesses, sometimes hires other companies to perform certain business-related functions on its behalf, and we may provide access to or share your information with these companies so they can perform Platform for us. Examples of such functions include marketing, mailing information, data storage, security, fraud preventions, payment processing, legal Platform, and maintaining databases.

### **Legal Requirements:**

- EdFunder may access, disclose, transfer and preserve your information when we have a good faith belief that doing so is necessary to: (i) comply with the law including with subpoenas, search warrants, court orders, and other legal process; and respond to inquiries or requests from government, regulatory, law enforcement, public authorities, or content protection organizations; (ii) protect and defend the legal rights, privacy, safety or property of EdFunder, its affiliates, subsidiaries, employees, agents, contractors, or its users; (iii) permit us to pursue available remedies, commence, participate in, or defend litigation, or limit the damages we may sustain; or (iv) enforce this Privacy Policy or any applicable Terms and Conditions.
- Your consent
- We may share your information in the event that you consent to the sharing of your information.
- Aggregate and/or De-Identified Information
- We may aggregate and/or de-identify your information so that the information no longer relates to you individually. Our use and disclosures of such aggregated or de-identified information is not subject to this Privacy Policy, and may be disclosed to others without limitation and for any purpose.
- Analytics
- We may use third-party web analytics Platform on our Platform, such as those of Google Analytics. These service providers use the sort of technology previously described in the “Cookies and other electronic technologies” section to help us analyze how users use the Platform, including by noting the third-party website from which you arrive, and provide certain features to you. The information (including your IP address) collected by the technology will be disclosed to or collected directly by these service providers, who use the information to evaluate your use of the Platform. This information may be used to place interest-based advertisements on the Platform. This may result in you seeing advertisements for our Platform when you visit other websites. To prevent Google Analytics from using your information for analytics, you may install the Google Analytics [Opt-out Browser Add-on by clicking here](#).

### **Tailored Advertising**

We may use third-party advertising technologies that allow for the delivery of relevant

content and advertising on our Platform, as well as on other websites you visit. The ads may be based on various factors such as the content of the page you are visiting, information you enter such as your age and gender, your searches, demographic data, user-generated content, and other information we collect from you. These ads may be based on your current activity or your activity over time and across other websites and online Platform and may be tailored to your interests.

Also, third parties whose products or Platform are accessible or advertised on our Platform may place cookies or other tracking technologies on your computer, mobile phone, or other device to collect information about your use of the website as discussed above. We also allow other third parties (e.g., ad networks and ad servers such as Google Analytics, DoubleClick and others) to serve tailored ads to you on our website, other sites, and in other applications, and to access their own cookies or other tracking technologies on your computer, mobile phone, or other device you use to access the website. We may provide our customer information (such as a hashed version of your email addresses) to service providers, who may “match” this information in de-identified form to cookies (or mobile ad identifiers) and other proprietary IDs, in order to target or “retarget” you with ads when you visit other websites and mobile applications. (You may opt out of these many of these service providers as described in the next paragraph.) We neither have access to, nor does this Privacy Policy govern, the use of cookies or other tracking technologies that may be placed on your computer, mobile phone, or other device you use to access our website by non-affiliated, third-party ad technology, ad servers, ad networks or any other non-affiliated third parties. Those parties that use these technologies may offer you a way to opt out of ad targeting as described below.

Also, we do not control any of the above opt-out links or whether any particular company chooses to participate in these opt-out programs. We are not responsible for any choices you make using these mechanisms or the continued availability or accuracy of these mechanisms.

## **Unsolicited Information**

Please be advised that some information you provide may be publicly accessible, such as information posted in forums or comment sections. We may also collect information through customer support communications, your communication to us of ideas for new products or modifications to existing products, and other unsolicited submissions (collectively, with publicly-accessible information, "Unsolicited Information"). By sending us Unsolicited Information, you further (a) agree that we are under no obligation of confidentiality, express or implied, with respect to the Unsolicited Information, (b) acknowledge that we may have something similar to the Unsolicited Information already under consideration or in development, (c) grant us an irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, worldwide license to use, modify, prepare derivative works, publish, distribute and sublicense the Unsolicited Information, and (iv) irrevocably waive, and cause to be waived, against EdFunder and its users any claims and assertions of any moral rights contained in such Unsolicited Information. This Unsolicited Information section shall survive any termination of your account or the Platform. This Privacy Policy otherwise does not apply to any information collected by EdFunder other than information collected through the Platform.

## **Children**

Our Platform are not designed for use by individuals under the age of 13. If you are under the age of 13, please do not use the Platform and/or submit any information through the Platform. If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of 13 has provided personal information to EdFunder through the Platform, please contact us [support@edfunder.com](mailto:support@edfunder.com), and we will delete that information from our databases to the extent required by law.

## **Links to Other Web Sites**

This Privacy Policy applies only to the Platform. The Platform may contain links to other web sites not operated or controlled by EdFunder (the "Third-Party Sites"). The policies and procedures we described here do not apply to the Third-Party Sites. The links from the Platform do not imply that EdFunder endorses or has reviewed the Third-Party Sites. We suggest contacting those sites directly for information on their respective privacy policies.

## **Security**

EdFunder takes steps to protect the Personal Data provided via the Platform from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, no Internet or email transmission is ever fully secure or error free. In particular, email sent to or from the Platform may not be secure. **Do-Not-Track Signals**
